PROCEDURAL RULING GRANTING MOTION FOR FURTHER CONTINUANCE

Counsel for Mr. Brian Walding, the Chapter 11 Bankruptcy Trustee for Eco-Preservation Services, LLC ("ECO"), filed a Motion for Continuance on or about June 12, 2025 urging the Commission to further defer consideration of ECO's pending Application for Reconsideration, Rehearing or Modification of the Commission's November 26, 2024 Order in this cause until no earlier than August 5, 2025. Mr. Walding again represents he is still in the process of finalizing his assessment of the vast number of issues related to ECO and needs the additional time requested to formulate a proper response to the matters being considered by the Commission.

Based on the circumstances presented by Mr. Walding, the Commission will delay further consideration of ECO's Application for Reconsideration, Rehearing or Modification until no earlier than August 5, 2025 absent a compelling demonstration that a different course of action is justified.
