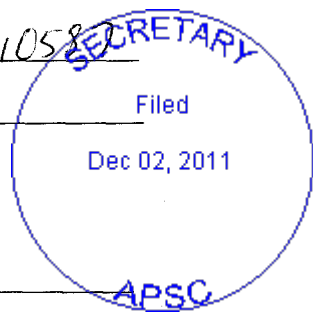

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

CHANGING SPACES MOVING, INC.

KNOWN ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned, desiring to become a body corporate for the purposes hereinafter stated, under and pursuant to the provisions of the Alabama Business Corporation Act of 1981, as amended, do hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

CHANGING SPACES MOVING, INC.

ARTICLE II

The nature of the business and objects for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

- (a) To contract and provide a service to customers in many areas related to the transportation, rigging, and moving industries either local, rural, city, county, state or nationwide, which can include but not limited to the moving and relocation of contents of an apartment, household, business, or storage facility. Service can also include the moving of furniture, appliances, machinery, office and/or commercial equipment. Services may also include cleaning, mailing, shipping, crating and uncrating of items. Services maybe sub-contracted to or with other moving companies to meet the requirements, needs and deadlines of customers.
- (B) Other services and/or products to be made readily available to customers is sale of boxes and other materials used for packing, box delivery, packing and

unpacking of items; the loading and unloading of rental trucks, the loading, unloading and storage of P.O.Ds; the leasing of storage spaces.

- (b) To do anywhere within or without the State of Alabama any or all of these enumerated things and anything necessary, suitable, convenient or proper in the accomplishment of any of these or anything incidental thereto or anything which shall at any time appear desirable for the protection or benefit of the corporation.

ARTICLE III

INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT

The initial registered office of the corporation is 2700 Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Birmingham, Alabama 35242, and the name of the initial registered agent at such address is **R. Joe Planson**. The corporation may maintain such other offices elsewhere, within or without the State of Alabama, as its Board of Directors may from time to time determine.

ARTICLE VI

CAPITAL STOCK

The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have the authority to issue shall be One hundred (100) Shares of the par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share.

DURATION

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IX

The stockholders shall not be personally liable for the payment of the corporation's debts and obligations to any extent whatsoever.

ARTICLE X

BY-LAWS

The corporate powers of the corporation shall be exercised by the Board of Directors, except as otherwise provided by law. The date on which the Directors' meetings shall be held, the number of Directors and their terms of office, and the terms of office of the officers, and the powers and duties of the officers shall be fixed by the by-laws of the corporation. Other offices and those named herein may be created by the by-laws of the corporation and filled by the Board of Directors. The corporation shall have power to make by-laws for the regulation and government of the corporation, its agents, servants and officers, and for all other purposes not inconsistent with the Constitution and laws of the State of Alabama.

ARTICLE XI

The corporation reserves the right to create any preferred or special class of stock and bonds and to amend or repeal any provisions contained in the certificate of incorporation or any amendment thereof, in the manner now or hereafter provided by the laws of the State of Alabama. All rights of the stockholders of the corporation are created subject to the aforementioned reservations.

ARTICLE XII

This corporation shall have the right to purchase shares of its own capital stock from time to time in such amounts and at such price as may be fixed by the Board of Directors at that time acting; and may either retire such stock so acquired or hold the same as treasury stock subject to later reissue, as the said Board of Directors may desire.
