PROCEDURAL RULING

The Office of the Attorney General filed a motion on April 23, 2026, to Request for the Public Service Commission to Give Additional Consideration to Attorney General Recommendations. A procedural ruling was issued on April 24, 2026, giving Camp Hill Utility Board ("Camp Hill") 30 days to respond. As of today's date, no formal filing in response has been filed by Camp Hill. According to Commission staff, Camp Hill is still not within compliance. As such, the Attorney General's motion to Request for the Public Service Commission to Give Additional Consideration to Attorney General Recommendations is set for a hearing on August 25, 2026 at 1:00 PM in the Commission's Carl L. Evans, Chief Administrative Law Judge Hearing Complex, at 100 North Union Street, Room 900, Montgomery, Alabama 36104.
