PROCEDURAL RULING

An Order was issued in this matter on February 3, 2026. Camp Hill Utility Board (“Camp Hill”) was fined up \$30,000 if certain requirements were not met by set deadlines, with up to \$5,000 offset of Commission approved expenditures to get its system in full compliance. In the February 3, 2026 Order, the Commission stated it would give additional consideration to the Office of the Attorney General’s initial recommendation if Camp Hill failed to become complaint by the set deadlines.

As of today’s date, the deadlines have passed, and Camp Hill is not in full compliance. On April 10, 2026, the Office of the Attorney General filed a Motion to Enforce Commission Order. Camp Hill responded via electronic mail on April 15, 2026. A conference call, in which all parties participated, was held regarding the Attorney General’s motion on April 22, 2026. At the Commission’s suggestion, the Office of the Attorney General restyled and refiled its motion as Request for the Public Service Commission to Give Additional Consideration to Attorney General Recommendations.

Having considered the Commission's initial order, the Attorney General's motions and what was discussed between the parties on the April 22, 2026 conference call, the following is ordered. The Attorney General's motion to Request for the Public Service Commission to Give Additional Consideration to Attorney General Recommendations has superseded its April 10, 2026 Motion. Therefore, the Attorney General's Motion to Enforce Commission Order is DISMISSED. Also, it is ordered that Camp Hill has 30 days from the date of this Procedural Ruling to respond to the Attorney General's motion to Request for the Public Service Commission to Give Additional Consideration to Attorney General Recommendations.

IT IS SO RULED.
