REPORT AND ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed on July 9, 2026 as supplemented on July 27, 2026, Vero Fiber ABS, LLC, 3575 Ringsby Court, Suite #320, Denver, Colorado 80216, seeks a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide telecommunications services in the State of Alabama.

Pursuant to notice dated July 17, 2026, the application was heard on August 25, 2026. The Applicant's General Counsel, Chris Pietila, testified at the hearing. Members of the Commission Staff also participated in the hearing. There were no intervenors. On August 27, 2026, the Applicant made a post-hearing filing providing supplemental information in response to questions raised at the hearing.

It appears from the record in this proceeding, and we find, that the Applicant has demonstrated that it possesses the technical, managerial, and financial resources to provide the services proposed. Accordingly, it appears that the Applicant should be granted a certificate authorizing the provision of facilities-based and resold telecommunications services, including local exchange, exchange access, and interexchange services, consistent with the services similarly situated applicants have been authorized to provide.

The Telecommunications Service authorized herein must be provided in compliance with the rules and regulations governing such service as authorized by this Commission in its September 20, 1995, Report and Order in Dockets 24030, 24472, 24499 and 24865, as well as all other applicable rules and regulations of the Commission. Further, the Applicant's certification to provide Telecommunications Services will expire in one (1) year if the Applicant has not submitted for Commission approval an interconnection/resale contract or agreement for local service and has not filed a final tariff governing said service.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED BY THE COMMISSION, That a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity is hereby issued to Vero Fiber ABS, LLC, 3575 Ringsby Court, Suite #320, Denver, Colorado 80216, authorizing operations as a provider of facilities-based and resold telecommunications services, including local exchange, exchange access, and interexchange services, in all areas of the State of Alabama.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED BY THE COMMISSION, That the services herein authorized may be commenced only after the Applicant has filed with this Commission a final tariff governing said services which has been approved by the Commission and an interconnection/resale contract or agreement with all applicable incumbent local exchange carriers. Unless the Applicant complies with these requirements within one (1) year after the date of this Order, or within such additional time as may be authorized by the Commission, the grant of authority made in this Order shall be considered as null and void and the petition shall stand denied in its entirety effective upon the expiration of said compliance time.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED BY THE COMMISSION, That the Applicant shall file annual reports and shall maintain adequate books of account and financial records in accordance with the rules and regulations promulgated by this Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED BY THE COMMISSION, That any changes, including name, address, telephone number(s), contact personnel, or other pertinent information concerning the Applicant, shall be filed with this Commission by written transmittal letter within thirty (30) days of such change.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED BY THE COMMISSION, That the Applicant shall render sufficient and continuous service in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Commission and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That jurisdiction in this cause is retained for the issuance of any further order or orders as this Commission may find just and reasonable.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that this Order shall be effective as of the date hereof.
