This letter will confirm our phone conversation this morning in the above referenced matter, wherein we agreed upon a restriction being entered into your application. It is my understanding you will amend your application to read as follows:

EXTEND an existing operation under Motor Carrier Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity 4015 as a **COMMON CARRIER** by motor vehicle in intrastate commerce over **IRREGULAR ROUTES** in the transportation of Passengers and their baggage. (1) Between all points in Shelby, Talladega, St. Clair, Chilton, Bibb, Cullman, Coosa, Blount, Walker and Jefferson, Tallapoosa and Lee Counties; and (2) From all points in (1) above, to all points in the State of Alabama. RESTRICTION: Restricted against the provision of non-emergency medical transportation services. **Restricted against the transportation of Railroad crews within the above requested service areas.**
