### **ORDER**

#### **BY THE COMMISSION:**

By application filed on or about December 10, 2025, Prestige Limousine Service, Inc., 2254 17<sup>th</sup> Street, Tuscaloosa, Alabama 35701 (13974 Stone Harbour Drive, Northport, Alabama 35473), and Crown Limousine & Sedan Service LLC, 521 30<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Northport, Alabama 35476, seek authority from the Commission to transfer Motor Carrier Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity 3652 from the latter to the former.

Pursuant to notice dated January 5, 2026, the Commission notified all interested parties that this cause was pending before the Commission and that unless request for public hearing was received on this matter on or before January 23, 2026, the same would be disposed of without a public hearing. No request for public hearing was received on or before January 23, 2026, and none has been received since that time.

It appears from the record in this cause, and we find, that the proposed Transferee is in all respects qualified under the applicable provisions of law to conduct the services contemplated under Certificate 3652, and that the proposed transfer is required by the public convenience and necessity.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED BY THE COMMISSION, That Motor Carrier Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity 3652, heretofore issued by the Commission and now standing in the name of Crown Limousine & Sedan Service LLC, 521 30<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Northport, Alabama 35476, is hereby transferred to Prestige Limousine Service, Inc., 2254 17<sup>th</sup> Street, Tuscaloosa, Alabama 35701, authorizing operations as a common carrier by motor vehicle in the intrastate transportation of:

Passengers and their baggage in vehicles with a seating capacity of fourteen (14) passengers or less between all points and places within the State of Alabama.

**RESTRICTIONS:**

- (1) Restricted against transportation services originating in Mobile and Baldwin Counties, Alabama;
- (2) Restricted against transportation service in luxury limousines originating in Lee, Macon, Henry, Houston, Dale, Geneva, and Coffee Counties, Alabama; and
- (3) Restricted against the provision of non-emergency medical transportation services in all counties except Greene, Pickens, and Tuscaloosa Counties, Alabama.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED BY THE COMMISSION, That the operations herein authorized may be commenced only after the Transferee has filed with this Commission evidence of liability insurance coverage as required by the rules and regulations of this Commission, tariffs, and has obtained registration numbers and properly identified its vehicles as required by the rules and regulations of this Commission. Unless the Transferee complies with these requirements within 90 days after the date of this Order, or within such additional time as may be authorized by the Commission, the grant of authority made in this Order shall be considered as null and void and the application shall stand denied in its entirety effective upon the expiration of said compliance time.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED BY THE COMMISSION, That the operations herein authorized shall be subject to all the rights, privileges and immunities as well as all the restrictions, liabilities and responsibilities that are now or may hereafter be imposed by law, or the rules and regulations of this Commission upon common carriers by motor vehicle.


