ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

Effective 30 days from the January 7, 2025, Order of Revocation entered in this proceeding, Broker's License No. 49 held by Glovis America, Inc., 18191 Van Karman Avenue, Irvine, California 92612, (3235 Satellite Boulevard, Suite 400, Duluth, Georgia 30096) was revoked for failure to maintain proper proof of a broker surety bond as required by law.

On or about March 12, 2025, the Petitioner provided information to show that the broker surety bond required by law had been maintained in full force and effect continuously, but proper proof of such coverage did not reach the Commission due to an error by the insurer in submitting the required documentation.

As the Petitioner has satisfactorily demonstrated that the required broker surety bond has been properly maintained and now been properly presented, it appears that the effective date of the Order of Revocation issued on January 7, 2025, should be extended.

Therefore, pursuant to the Commission's Order in Informal Docket U-4716, dated January 17, 2006, the effective date of the Order of Revocation issued on January 7, 2025, is hereby extended to and through April 30, 2025.

Jurisdiction in this proceeding will be retained for any Commission order or orders, including general orders, that may appear to be warranted in the future.
