### **ORDER**

#### **BY THE COMMISSION:**

On February 23, 2024, Eco-Preservation Services, LLC (“Eco-Preservation”), a sewer service provider, filed a petition for approval of tariff revisions. Finding that the requested tariff revisions required additional study and investigation, the Commission suspended Eco-Preservation’s proposed tariff revisions for 180 days from the requested effective date of June 1, 2024, to and through November 27, 2024. A hearing was held on September 11-12, 2024. On

November 26, 2024, the Commission issued an order denying Eco-Preservation's proposed tariff revisions and setting final rates.

On December 23, 2024, Eco-Preservation filed a motion for reconsideration, rehearing, or modification of the Commission's order setting final rates ("Motion to Reconsider"). Shortly after the filing of the Motion to Reconsider, the Commission received notice that the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Alabama had appointed a trustee for Eco-Preservation. On January 28, 2025, an attorney for the Trustee requested a continuance of the decision on the Motion to Reconsider. This requested continuance was granted. At the Trustee's request, the continuance was extended several times. On January 12, 2026, the Trustee moved to withdraw the Motion to Reconsider.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED BY THE COMMISSION that the Trustee for Eco-Preservation Services, LLC's motion to withdraw the pending Motion to Reconsider is granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order shall be effective as of the date hereof.
