ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed on or about August 7, 2010, Tariq Qureshi, an individual, d/b/a The Birmingham Metro Cab Company, 1205 Edwards Lake Circle, Birmingham, Alabama 35235, and Varavuti Saeksaisakul & Clarence Portis, d/b/a The Birmingham Cab Company, Post Office Box 320559 (512 Pope Drive, Pelham, Alabama 35124), Birmingham, Alabama 35232, seek authority from the Commission to transfer Motor Carrier Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity 3744 from the latter to the former.

Pursuant to notice dated August 9, 2010, the Commission notified all interested parties that this cause was pending before the Commission and that unless request for public hearing was received on this matter on or before August 23, 2010, the same would be disposed of without a public hearing. No request for public hearing was received on or before August 23, 2010, and none has been received since that time.

It appears from the record in this cause, and we find, that the proposed Transferee is in all respects qualified under the applicable provisions of law to conduct the services contemplated under Motor Carrier Certificate 3744, and that the proposed transfer is required by the public convenience and necessity.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED BY THE COMMISSION, That Motor Carrier Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity 3744, heretofore issued by the Commission and now standing in the name of Varavuti Saeksaisakul & Clarence Portis, d/b/a The Birmingham Cab Company, Post Office Box 320559 (512 Pope Drive, Pelham, Alabama 35124), Birmingham, Alabama 35232, is hereby transferred to Tariq Qureshi, d/b/a The Birmingham Metro Cab Company, 1205 Edwards Lake Circle, Birmingham, Alabama 35235, authorizing operations as a common carrier in the intrastate transportation of:

Passengers and their baggage in special or charter taxi operations over irregular routes as follows:

- (A) From the Birmingham Airport, to
- (B) All points in Alabama and from points in (B) to points in (A).


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED BY THE COMMISSION, That the operations herein authorized may be commenced only after the Transferee has filed with this Commission evidence of liability insurance coverage and a tariff as required by the rules and regulations of this Commission, and has obtained registration numbers and properly identified its vehicles as required by the rules and regulations of this Commission. Unless the Transferee complies with these requirements within 90 days after the date of this Order, or within such additional time as may be authorized by the Commission, the grant of authority made in this Order shall be considered as null and void and the application shall stand denied in its entirety effective upon the expiration of said compliance time.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED BY THE COMMISSION, That the operations herein authorized shall be subject to all the rights, privileges and immunities as well as all the restrictions, liabilities and responsibilities that are now or may hereafter be imposed by law, or the rules and regulations of this Commission upon common carriers by motor vehicle.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That this Order shall be effective as of the date hereof.


