Dear Commissioners:

By order dated August 31, 2009 in the docket listed above, the Commission revoked the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”) it had previously granted CoreTel Alabama, Inc. (“CoreTel”) for “failure to timely submit the required interconnection/resale contracts or agreements.”

CoreTel hereby respectfully requests that the Commission reinstate CoreTel’s CPCN. CoreTel notes that it jointly filed its interconnection agreement with BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Alabama for the Commission’s approval on March 13, 2009. The Commission approved this joint petition by order dated April 7, 2009 in Docket No. U-4921. A copy of that order is attached for the Commission’s reference. CoreTel apologizes to the extent that it could and should have filed this information previously in the docket listed above.

CoreTel Alabama, Inc.'s Adoption of the Interconnection Agreement between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Alabama and MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC pursuant to §251 and §252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.

### ORDER ON JOINT MOTION

BY THE COMMISSION:

By filing received March 13, 2009, Petitioners BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Alabama and CoreTel Alabama, Inc. filed for approval of an Interconnection Agreement Pursuant to §251 and §252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996. Both parties represented that to the best of their knowledge said agreement did not discriminate against any other telecommunications carriers and that the agreement was consistent with the public interest. Since the agreement had been reached through negotiation and no other parties would be adversely affected, the parties asserted that the agreement could be approved without the need for a hearing.

Pursuant to §252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, this Commission is charged with approving or rejecting the negotiated interconnection agreements. The Act provides that the Commission may only reject such agreements if it finds that an agreement or any portion thereof discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement, or the implementation of such agreement or portion thereof is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. After reviewing the negotiated interconnection agreement between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Alabama and CoreTel Alabama, Inc. in the manner prescribed by the Telecommunications Act of 1996, the Commission found that the agreement was consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. The Commission further found that the agreement did not discriminate in any manner against any telecommunications carriers who were not parties to the agreement. The Commission entered its order approving the Interconnection Agreement between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Alabama and MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC in Docket U-3833 on November 8, 2006.

By filing received on March 13, 2009, CoreTel Alabama, Inc. seeks to adopt the Interconnection Agreement between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Alabama and MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC which was approved by the Commission pursuant to Order entered on November 8, 2006 in Docket U-3833. Said request by CoreTel Alabama, Inc. is made pursuant to the Commission's Telephone Rule T-27 and §252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996. Said request is, therefore, due to be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE COMMISSION, That the request of CoreTel Alabama, Inc. to adopt and opt-into the provision of the Interconnection Agreement between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Alabama and MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC approved by the Commission on November 8, 2006 in Docket U-3833, is hereby approved.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That this Order shall be effective as of the date hereof.
