

**REPORT AND ORDER**

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

By application filed on or about December 20, 1996, Luxury Limo, L.L.C., an Alabama limited liability company, 623 Magnolia Circle, Gulf Shores, Alabama 36542, seeks authority to institute a new operation as a common carrier by motor vehicle, in intrastate commerce over irregular routes, in the transportation of:

Passengers and their baggage.

- (1) Between all points and places in Baldwin County;
- (2) Between all points and places in Baldwin County on the one hand, and, on the other hand, Mobile and its police jurisdiction.

**RESTRICTION:** Restricted to transportation in luxury limousines having a maximum capacity of ten passengers.

Pursuant to notice dated January 3, 1997, the application was set for hearing on January 30, 1997. Notices of intention to protest were filed by John W. Sabatine, d/b/a Touch of Class Limousine and Mobile Bay Transportation Company, Inc., but were subsequently withdrawn and the application came on for hearing unopposed.

It appears from the record in this cause, and we find, that the Applicant is fit, willing and able to properly perform the service proposed, and to conform with the provisions of the Alabama Motor Carrier Act and the Commission's Motor Carrier Rules, and that the proposed service is and will be required by the present and future public convenience and necessity.



## DOCKET 25776 - #2

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED BY THE COMMISSION, That Motor Carrier Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity 3681 is hereby issued to Luxury Limo, L.L.C., an Alabama limited liability company, 623 Magnolia Circle, Gulf Shores, Alabama 36542, authorizing operations as a common carrier by motor vehicle, in intrastate commerce over irregular routes, in the transportation of:

Passengers and their baggage.

- (1) Between all points and places in Baldwin County;
- (2) Between all points and places in Baldwin County on the one hand, and, on the other hand, Mobile and its police jurisdiction.

RESTRICTION: Restricted to transportation in luxury limousines having a maximum capacity of ten passengers.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED BY THE COMMISSION, That the operations herein authorized may be commenced only after the Applicant has filed with this Commission evidence of liability insurance and a tariff as required by the rules and regulations of this Commission, and has obtained registration numbers and properly identified its vehicles as required by the rules and regulations of this Commission. Unless the Applicant complies with these requirements within 90 days after the date of this order, or within such additional time as may be authorized by the Commission, the grant of authority made in this order shall be considered as null and void and the application shall stand denied in its entirety effective upon the expiration of said compliance time.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED BY THE COMMISSION, That the operations herein authorized shall be subject to all the rights, privileges and immunities, as well as all the restrictions, liabilities and responsibilities that are now or may hereafter be imposed by law, or the rules and regulations of this Commission upon common carriers by motor vehicle.


