AT&T Alabama has received a courtesy copy of a "notice" from Express Phone Service, Inc. ("Express Phone") purporting to unilaterally adopt an interconnection agreement different from its current and effective Agreement on file with the Commission in Docket No. U-4151. Please be advised that AT&T Alabama objects and does not consent to Express Phone's letter and asserts that the letter does not alter the effectiveness of the current Agreement between AT&T Alabama and Express Phone, which was signed by both parties and approved by the Commission.

As previously indicated in AT&T Alabama's Notice of Suspension and Disconnection dated February 23, 2011, AT&T Alabama intends to move forward with disconnection of service to Express Phone today if Express Phone does not cure its non-payment breach.
